

Made from Italian green marble and alabaster, this was gift in 1900 from Sir Theodore Martin in memory of his wife, Lady Helen Faucit, a famous Victorian Shakespearean actress.

Among the statues is St. Helena, mother of the Emperor Constantine and finder of the true cross, but her face is that of Helen Faucit.

The pulpit has never been universally liked; the vicar at the time of its installation refused to attend the dedication service as he did not approve of the design!
