



## St Peter's Chapel

The South transept is known as St Peters Chapel, and is used extensively for private services, weddings and Morning and Evening Prayer.

The very impressive stained glass window is called 'The American Window', installed in 1896 and funded by US public donation. The design depicts the Madonna and Child and the Adoration of the Magi, together with prominent holy figures, including William Penn, Christopher Columbus, the Pilgrim Fathers landing at Plymouth Rock and many others.

Two prominent memorials are worthy of note here, one of Richard Hill a bailiff and draper (etched in Greek, Hebrew, Latin and English) and a plaque tribute to WW1 "players who fell 1914-1919", with words by Rudyard Kipling.
