A 1611 version of the King James Translated Bible is located in a secure display case. This is a chained bible. Books were very expensive and were secured to prevent theft.

This actual bible would have been in use in Holy Trinity Church during William Shakespeare's retirement to Stratford, and as a worshipper at the church and a prominent member of the town's society, it is possible that he may have read from it during a service.
