## **THE LITURGY OF BAPTISM**

### **PRESENTATION OF THE CANDIDATES**

*The president invites the candidates for baptism  
to face the congregation and asks them.*

*President* Do you wish to be baptised?  
*Candidates* **I do**

*The president addresses the whole congregation*

*President* Faith is the gift of God to his people.  
In baptism the Lord is adding to our number  
those whom he is calling.  
People of God, will you welcome  
these candidates and uphold  
them in their new life in Christ?  
*All* **With the help of God, we will.**

## **THE DECISION**

*The president addresses the candidates directly,*

*President* We all wander far from God and lose our way:  
Christ comes to find us and welcomes us home.  
In baptism we respond to his call.  
Therefore I ask:

*Candidates* Do you turn away from sin?  
**I do**

*President* Do you reject evil?  
*Candidates* **I do**

*The candidates are invited to turn and face the cross on the High Altar*

*President* Do you turn to Christ as Saviour?  
*Candidates* **I do**

*President* Do you trust in him as Lord?  
*Candidates* **I do**

## **SIGNING WITH THE CROSS –**

*The president makes the sign of the cross with the oil of baptism  
on the forehead of each candidate, saying:*

*President* Christ claims you for his own.  
Receive the sign of his cross.

*The Parents and Godparents are invited to make the sign also.  
When all the candidates have been signed, the president says:*

*President* Do not be ashamed of Christ.  
You are his forever.

**All** **Stand bravely with him  
against all the powers of evil,  
and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life.**

*President* May almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness,  
and lead you in the light and obedience of Christ.

**All** **Amen.**

*The candidates for baptism and first communion, accompanied by their Parents and Godparents, process to the back of Church as we sing:*

***Please stand***

*To all the candidates the president says:*

*President* Today is a joyful occasion that marks an important stage in your Christian journey. Having spent a number of weeks in careful preparation for this occasion, I am going to ask you three questions about your Christian belief.

*President* Do you believe in God the Father, who gives you life,  
knows you by name and loves you?

**Candidates** **I do.**

*President* Do you believe in his Son Jesus Christ, who loves you,  
who died and has given you a new life by rising again?

**Candidates** **I do.**

*President* Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, who is alive in you  
and makes you holy?

**Candidates** **I do.**

*The President addresses the congregation*

*President* Do you believe in God the creator who gives us life,  
in Jesus who gives us new life  
and in the Holy Spirit who makes us holy?

**All**                    **We do.**

## **THE BAPTISM**

*The president pours water on each candidate, saying:*

*President*            *N, I baptise you  
in the name of the Father,  
and of the Son,  
and of the Holy Spirit.*

**All**                    **Amen.**

*The president prays for those who have been baptised, saying:*

*President*            *May God, who has received you by baptism into his Church,  
pour upon you the riches of his grace, that within the  
company of Christ's pilgrim people you may daily be re-  
newed by his anointing Spirit, and come to the inheritance of  
the saints in glory.*

**All**                    **Amen.**

*The other candidates for First Communion come to the font  
and sign themselves with a cross as a reminder of their own baptism.*

*Everyone returns to the front of the nave*

time when you come to be confirmed.

***The community expresses its joy and welcome with applause***

*The candidates are given a book, cross and certificate*

As a sign of our welcome and as a reminder of this happy  
day we give you each a book and a cross. We pray that as  
you read your books and look upon your cross you will real-  
ise how much the Lord loves you. We ask you to accept  
these gifts with our love and as a sign of our welcome and  
fellowship in the name of God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

If you are going to the back please make your way down the side aisles to avoid congestion in the centre aisle.

Whichever station you are going to, please wait until invited to make your way there. Thank you.
