Overview and general duties

The principal purpose of the Organist is to support the role of the Director of Music by accompanying the Choir at rehearsals and services, assisting in the musical development of the Choir (in collaboration with the Assistant Director of Music) and deputising for the Director of Music during planned absences and leave.

Key Duties and Responsibilities

1. Playing the organ to a high standard for rehearsals and statutory and special services, including accompanying the choir, as required.
2. Actively seek to undertake personal musical preparation and practice and the learning of new repertoire.
3. Playing for a share of non-choral services during choir holidays.
4. Deputising for the Director of Music or Assistant Director Music as required.
5. Playing for non-statutory services (fees available) as and when requested.
6. Other duties as directed by the Director of Music.
